

VILLAGE OF BREWSTER
PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO
BREWSTER VILLAGE CODE

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Brewster, Putnam County, New York, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 236, Sections 236-5(1) is hereby amended to read as follows:

Chapter 236

TAXICABS

§ 236-5. Application for taxi operator's license.

A. Each applicant for a taxi operator's license must comply with the following to the satisfaction of the Clerk:

(1) He/she must first have a valid New York State Class E Driver's License, or a valid New York State CDL Driver's License.

Section 2. Chapter 236, Sections 236-5(9) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

Chapter 236

TAXICABS

§ 236-5. Application for taxi operator's license.

A. Each applicant for a taxi operator's license must comply with the following to the satisfaction of the Clerk:

(9) He/she shall be subject to, and by submission of the application agrees to be subject to, periodic driver's license status checks in which the Village of Brewster will obtain from the New York State Department of Motor Vehicles the driving record of the applicant or licensee (the "driving record"). The driving record may be obtained by the Village upon submission of the application, prior to the issuance of a taxi operator's license. The driving record may also be obtained by the Village of Brewster periodically throughout the period the license is in effect, as well as upon any application to renew the license. The driving record may be obtained by the Village of Brewster without prior notice to the taxi operator or applicant, and the taxi operator's license may be subject to suspension or revocation depending upon the results of the driving record, and an application to obtain or renew a license may be denied based upon the driving record.

Section 3. If any provision of this local law shall be deemed by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions of this local law shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This local law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State of the State of New York.
