

Local Law No. ___ of 2015 of the Village of Brewster, County of Putnam and State of New York

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Brewster, Putnam County, New York, as follows:

EXTENSION OF A LOCAL LAW REGULATING, FOR AN INTERIM PERIOD, THE ISSUANCE OF BUILDING PERMITS, APPROVAL OF SUBDIVISION PLATS AND SITE DEVELOPMENT PLANS, AND THE GRANTING OF SPECIAL USE PERMITS AND VARIANCES

Section 1 Local Law

Chapter 150 of the Code of the Village of Brewster is hereby extended for a period of three (3) months from the effective date of this local law.

Section 2 Headings:

The headings and captions in this local law are for convenience of reference and in no way define, limit or describe the scope of this local law and shall not be considered an interpretation of this local law or any provision hereof.

Section 3 Singular to be Read as Plural:

Any singular word or term herein shall also be read as in the plural, and vice versa, and the neuter shall include the masculine and/or feminine gender, and vice versa, whenever necessary to give full effect to the provisions of this local law.

Section 4 Effective Date:

This local law shall take effect immediately, as provided by law, and shall remain in force for a consecutive period of three (3) months from its effective date, unless extended by local law adopted after public hearing upon no less than ten (10) days notice published in the official newspaper of the Village of Brewster.
