The notice to the media shall consist of a fax or email to the news desk of a daily paper such as The Journal-News, posting of the meeting on the Village Bulletin Board, notice in the Village office, and notification via the internet on the Village of Brewster web site, and via email to the general public who have access to such services. Every effort must be made to make the Board of Trustees and the residents of the Village as well as the general public aware of the need, purpose, time and location of the SPECIAL MEETING.

SPECIAL USE OF VILLAGE VEHICLES

The list of Village vehicles subject to this provision includes, but is not limited to, the following: a vehicle for use of the Water Superintendent, a K-9 police vehicle, and a police vehicle for the Chief of Police.
